

Order
on the approval of the study programme for the awarding of the certificate of completion of
the Teacher Training Department

Having regard to the provisions in the Article 68 of the Education Law no. 84/1995, republished, with its subsequent amendments,

Having regard to the Law 128/1997 on the Statute of the Teaching Staff, republished, with its subsequent amendments,

Having regard to the Law 288/2004 on the organisation of university studies,

In compliance with the provisions in the O.M.E.R. no. 3235/2005 on the organisation of first degree programmes,

Having regard to the Government Decision no. 223/2005 on the organisation and operation of the Ministry of Education and Research,

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND RESEARCH HAS ISSUED
THIS ORDER:

Article 1

This order regulates the psychological and pedagogical study programme leading to the awarding of the certificate of completion of the Teacher Training Department. This certificate entitles the holder to practice the teaching profession.

Article 2

From the academic year 2005 – 2006, the Teacher Training Departments from universities shall organise the study programme for the awarding of the certificate of completion in compliance with the syllabus in the annex herein.

Article 3

The study programme for the awarding of the certificate of completion is structured in two modules, as follows:

a) Module 1 (30 credits)

1. It shall be attended during the semesters of the first degree programmes, during the study programme for years I – III/IV.
2. Completion of the first module ends with the awarding of a completion document and an annex including the student's achievements, issued by the Teacher Training Department and approved by the rector of the higher education institution.
3. The completion document represents a partial certification for the teaching profession and entitles the holder to work temporary as a teacher until he/she gets "on the job confirmation", in accordance with the rules in force.

b) Module 2 (30 credits)

1. It shall be attended after being awarded the first degree diploma and prior to the “on the job confirmation” examination. The Module 2 may be attended both by students who enrol in master programmes and by those who decide not to continue their studies after the completion of a first degree programme.
2. The completion of the Module 2 ends with the awarding of *the completion certificate*. The completion certificate includes and replaces the completion document issued previously (the partial certification).
3. The registration for taking the “on the job confirmation” examination is conditioned by the awarding of the certificate of completion of Teacher Training Department.

Article 4

- (1) The people who do not attend the Modules 1 and 2 during their first degree and master studies may enrol later in postgraduate courses at the Teacher Training Departments in order to obtain the completion certificate.
- (2) The Teacher Training Departments of universities shall organise postgraduate studies for the completion certificate periodically, with the same syllabus, presented in the annex, and with a fee approved by the Senate of the university.

Article 5

- (1) For the optional subjects of the Module 1, the offer may include psychological and pedagogical subjects proposed by the Teacher Training Department or optional subjects specified in the two packages of the Module 2.
- (2) The offer of optional subjects of the Module 1 shall include at least 2 subjects.
- (3) The students who studied within the Module 1 one of the optional subjects specified in the Module 2 shall select, while attending the Module 2, one of the other subjects available in that package.

Article 6

- (1) The final assessment at the end of the Module 1 leading to the awarding of the completion document shall be done through a didactic portfolio that shall contain evidence of psychological, pedagogical and methodical training and of the practical pedagogical training achieved by a student.
- (2) The final assessment at the end of the Module 2 leading to the awarding of the completion certificate shall be done based on an applicative project related to the teaching methodology of the subject or the psychology and pedagogy specific to the learning of that subject.

Article 7

- (1) The graduates of Module 1 who do not work as teachers until the attendance of Module 2 have to do a 42 hours practical training within the Module 2.
- (2) The Teacher Training Departments are responsible for the organisation of the practical training, based on the existing needs, by concluding collaboration agreements with pre-university education institutions.

Article 9

The graduates of first degree programmes in the field of “education sciences” are considered certified on the ground of their graduation diploma, provided that the syllabuses of the first degree

programme include all the subjects required by the study programme for the awarding of the certificate of completion of the Teacher Training Department. The first degree diploma in the field of education science entitles the holder, provided that the conditions above are respected, to hold teaching positions.
